

How to Add Your LinkedIn URL to Your E-Mail Signature

Social Selling for Financial Professionals

Adding a link in your e-mail signature to your public LinkedIn profile is becoming as commonplace as a link to your website. Make it easy for clients and prospects to find your professional profile quickly by including this link in your e-mail signature. It only takes a few minutes to set up, and once you do, the link is automatically added to any e-mails you send.

Add LinkedIn URL to E-Mail Signature

- I. Visit LinkedIn.com and sign in. View your profile.
- 2. Below your picture and headline information you should see your unique LinkedIn public profile URL. If you have not customized your URL, it will include a string of numbers and letters. (If needed, refer to the How to Claim Your Custom LinkedIn URL guide for directions.) Select, right click, and copy this URL.
- 3. Access your e-mail signature editor, and add a new line that says, "View My LinkedIn Profile," or simply, "LinkedIn."
- **4.** Select this text and create a new hyperlink. In most cases, this is usually a button that looks like a chain link. Paste your profile URL into the address field and click "Ok."
- 5. Save your changes and exit your e-mail signature editor.
- 6. You should now see a link to your public LinkedIn profile in all new e-mail messages you create.
